

School Health Requirements for Students

Please Read Carefully

Dear Parents:

The State of Colorado requires the following health information for all preschool and kindergarten children:

- * **Certificate of Immunization Form** (or equivalent from doctor's office)
- * **Student Health Form** (white form provided by Montview)

Both forms MUST be submitted EACH YEAR. The deadline for receiving both forms in the School Office is July 31, 2010. Children who do not have current health records on file may not attend school.

Parent Directions:

- 1) Locate and print the Student Health Form and Certificate of Immunization Form from the Montview website.
- 2) Fill out the ENTIRE top portion of the Student Health Form.
- 3) Take the Student Health Form and Certificate of Immunization Form to the child's healthcare provider for completion. The health provider must complete both forms correctly. Most medical offices take several days to complete forms, so please plan ahead.
- 4) It is your responsibility to see that both forms are received in the Montview office. If your health provider agrees to fax forms to Montview, the fax number is 303-333-1276.
- 5) If your child will require any medications, including allergy medication, to be given during school hours, additional forms need to be signed by your child's health provider. Please call the school office, 303-322-7296, as soon as possible to discuss your child's medications.

Please note that Montview cannot accept Student Health Forms or Certificates of Immunization on which an immediate family member has signed as the Healthcare Provider.

Important Immunization Information Affecting Kindergarteners Only:

Kindergarteners must have had two Varicella (chickenpox) vaccines by the time of school entry, or the healthcare provider must verify that the child has had chickenpox.

Again, please plan ahead. If your child will need shots, it is best to make appointments now so that vaccines can be given and properly documented by **July 31, 2010.**
