Montview Community Preschool and Kindergarten is a Parent Cooperative school open to families of all races, religious faiths, and economic backgrounds.

Guide to Selecting Classes

- Morning vs. Afternoon classes – Parents often prefer morning classes for their preschoolers. We hope you will keep your mind open to an afternoon class as well. Many children do not do well if they are rushed to get up, get dressed, eat breakfast, brush teeth, etc. before hurrying off to school. Enrollment in an afternoon class allows a child to move through their morning routines at a more leisurely pace – a real advantage for some children! Also, by the age of 3 or 4, many children are ready to give up their afternoon naps. For those who do still nap, we find that they typically adjust well within the first few weeks of preschool to afternoon routines and engaging activities.
- 2-Day and 3-Day Classes – Two-day classes traditionally are best for young 3-year-olds and for 4-year-olds who have not had many other group experiences. Three-day classes are better suited to older 3-year-olds and to 4-year-olds who have had some previous class experience.
- 4-Day Classes – Our four-day classes are designed for 4- and 5-year-olds, and are taught by veteran Montview teachers. These classes meet on consecutive days which provide continuity in learning and allows for more in-depth project work.

Parent Responsibilities

Parent participation is required and responsibilities include:

- Assist the teachers in the classroom approximately once every 4 to 7 weeks.
- Attend Parent Orientation at the start of the school year with the classroom teacher.
- Set-up the classroom at the start of the school year or take-down the classroom at the end of the school year.
- Attend one Clean-Up Day during the year.
- Perform the duties of one Parent Job.
- Actively participate in annual fundraising.
- Meet your financial obligations to the school on schedule and according to the Parent Handbook guidelines.
